

Adding BHA Run record

Each **BHA Run** record consists of the following components:-

- a. **Basic Data**
- b. **BHA Daily Summary**
- c. **BHA Component**
- d. **Bit Run**

Bit Run has a sub-record called **Bit Run Nozzles**.

1. When it comes to creating BHA Run, you have the options to **Continue from Previous Run** or **Create New BHA Run**.




Figure 1.1 The 'Continue From Previous Run' and 'Create New BHA Run' buttons

Continue From Previous Run

1. Select a **Well** record and a **Day** record from the **Well Operations** and **Day** selectors respectively.
2. Mouse-over the **DrillNet** tab and select **BHA Run** from the drop down menu that is displayed. This will load the **BHA Run** page, showing the existing record associated with the selected **Well** and **Day** records.




Figure 1.2 Accessing the BHA Run page

3. Click the **Continue from Previous Run** button.
4. You will be prompted to select the available **BHA Run #** record of your choice.




Figure 1.4 BHA Run # pop-up prompt

5. Click the **Confirm** button to lock the selection.
6. If you choose to record this entry as a new **BHA Run**, change the **BHA Run #** and **Bit Run #** numbers.

7. Click the **Confirm** button to save the **BHA Run** record.

Create New BHA Run

1. To create a new **BHA Run** record, select a **Well** record and a **Day** record from the **Well Operations** and **Day** selectors respectively.
2. Mouse-over the **DrillNet** tab and select **BHA Run** from the drop down menu that is displayed.

This will load the **BHA Run** page, showing the existing record associated with the selected **Well** and **Day** records.




Figure 1.7 Accessing the BHA Run page

3. Click the **Add New** button.
4. Enter the **BHA Run Number** next to the **BHA Run #** label. This information is required and should not be left blank.
 - 4.1 To add the **BHA Daily Summary**, click the **Add BHA Daily Summary** button. Once the page has loaded, enter the necessary **BHA Daily Summary** information.

- 4.2 To add the **BHA Component**, click the **Add BHA Component** button. Once the page has loaded, enter the necessary BHA Daily Summary information.

- 4.3 You can also choose to copy a **Previous Run** record of the **BHA Component**. To do so, click the **BHA Component from Previous Run** button.




Figure 1.9 The 'Add BHA Component' and 'Copy BHA From Previous Run' buttons

- 4.4 To add the **Bit Run**, click the **Add Bit Run** button. Once the page has loaded, enter the necessary **Bit Run** information.
- 4.4.1 To add the Bit Run Nozzles, click the Add Bit Run Nozzles. Once the page has loaded, enter the necessary Bit Run Nozzles information.
- 4.5 You can also choose to copy a **Previous Run** record of the **Bit Run**. To do so, click the **BHA Component from Previous Run** button.
