GeoNet Quickstart Adding Formation Data record

- 1. To create a *Formation Data* record, first select a *Well* record and a *Day* record from the *Well Operations* and *Day* selectors respectively.
- 2. Mouse-over the **GeoNet** tab and select **Formation Data** from the drop down menu.

This will load the *Formation Data*, showing the existing record associated with the selected *Well* and *Day* records.
