- 1. To add **HSE** record, first select a **Well** record and a **Day** record from the **Well Operations** and **Day** selectors respectively.
- 2. Next, mouse-over the **SafeNet** menu tab and select **HSE** from the drop down menu.

- 4. To add a **HSE** record, click the **Add New** button at the top or the **Add HSE** button at the bottom of the page.
- 5. Fill up the Seq. #, Type, Num. Events, Short Description, Detail Description, Date/Time and Days Lapsed fields.
 - **Type** field refers to type of event that occurred on the particular day. It includes **Environmental Incident**, **Weekly Camp Inspection** etc.
 - *Num. Events* refers to the number of times the HSE events occurred.
 - The **Short Description** field as well as **Detail Description** field allows the client to key in details of the **HSE Activity**.

- The *Date/Time* field shows when the *HSE Event* occurred.
- **Days Lapsed** shows how many days since the **HSE Event** occurred
- If time is lost during the HSE Events, the record can be flagged to denote this under the Is
 Lost Time? field. Note that if the HSE Event is flagged as a "Yes", it will be used to
 calculate the Last LTI field found in the DrillNet > Daily Data page.
- 6. To save the record, click the Confirm button.
